



Curt G. Joa, Inc. Engineering Scholarship

These scholarships (valued at \$5000 one time) are available to all high school seniors who will be attending a 4 year college to pursue the field of **Electrical or Mechanical Engineering**. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits (full-time student) at an accredited post-secondary educational institution. The award will be granted when student presents verification of a 3.0 GPA in the Fall semester following presentation of the scholarship. In addition, the winner of the scholarship is entitled to a paid internship at Curt G. Joa, Inc. the summer following the completion of the student's freshman year (additional internships will be available based on the students work in first summer of internship). Items must be postmarked by: February 27, 2026.

Eligibility Requirements:

- High School Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Attending an accredited college pursuant of an Engineering Degree in Mechanical or Electrical Engineering.

Application Process:

To apply, students must submit the following on or before **February 27, 2026**.

- A completed scholarship application form
- Copy of Transcripts
- One academic reference letter
- One personal reference letter
